Chief Guest Soumitra Bhattacharya, CEO & Director, Indian Foundation for Quality Management (IFQM) Chairman & Director, Bosch Limited Former CEO & Managing Director, Bosch Ltd. Former President, Bosch Group India

Soumitra Bhattacharya, with a rich tenure of over 28 years at the Bosch Group, has exemplified diversified leadership across multiple geographies and functions. A Chartered Accountant by profession, his journey scaled from being the Vice President of Commercial Functions at Bosch's Nashik and Jaipur plants, to General Manager at the prestigious Feuerbach Plant in Germany, Bosch's largest diesel systems manufacturing hub.

His strategic foresight during 2005-2009 leading Bosch Turkey earned the distinguished EFQM award win in 2008. Following this, Soumitra steered Bosch Ltd. as the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) from 2011 to 2016 and then as Joint Managing Director (2012-2016) and later as Managing Director (2017-2023) and as the Regional President for the Bosch Group in India until his retirement on June 30, 2023.

He assumed the role of CEO and Director at Indian Foundation for Quality Management (IFQM) in July 2023, an initiative driven by captains of industry centered around Quality, Excellence, and Innovation.

Soumitra's professional voyage, spanning 39 years, began even before his time at Bosch, with key management roles at TATA Steel, IPITATA, INDAL, and as one of the founding members for Tanishq of Titan Company Limited..

Mr. T. V. Narendran is the CEO & Managing Director of Tata Steel Limited one of the largest steel producer in the world. As the CEO & MD, he has overseen the organic and inorganic growth of Tata Steel over the last few years. This includes the Kalinganagar greenfield expansion and the acquisition of Bhushan steel and the steel business of Usha Martin. He has over 34 years of experience in the Mining and Metals Industry.

Mr. Narendran is currently on the Board of Tata Steel Limited. He is the Chairman of Tata Steel Europe, Tata Steel BSL Limited and Tata Steel Long Products Limited. He is also the Chairman of the Board of Governors of XLRI Jamshedpur. He is a member of the Executive Committee and the Board of the World Steel Association. Mr. Narendran was involved in the journey of Deming Prize for Tata Steel with a focus on creation of customer value and societal value as a means for creating corporate value. Mr. Narendran is a Mechanical Engineer from the National Institute of Technology (NIT) Trichy and did his MBA from the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Calcutta. He is a recipient of Distinguished Alumnus Awards from both NIT Trichy and IIM Calcutta. He is a Chevening Scholar and has also attended the Advanced Management Program in CEDEP-INSEAD, Fontainebleau, France
