Key Learning's

In line with the theme of the conference, speakers shared case studies on how their companies actually overcame turbulent times to emerge stronger. It was amply clear from the presentations that the use of simple and effective quality tools by involving all employees is the most powerful antidote not only for short term sustenance but also for long term growth of an organization.

Mr. Kiran Deshmukh, former Deputy MD of Sona Koyo Steering Systems Ltd. summed up the key learning's from the case studies:

- 1. Methods of improvement are universal for all types of companies—discrete manufacturing, continuous manufacturing, service industry; small, medium, large.
- 2. The tools for quality improvement are simple yet powerful. Their application needs training and education of employees in the tools and an environment that is conducive to such applications.
- 3. Results of TQM take time to fructify, so we need a steadfast commitment and belief by the top management.
